The MasterClass will be held from 27 th January to 7 th February 2020.

www.metrolab.brussels	Brussels Urban Production is centred on a common goal: to better understand how the interactions between production in the city (productive activities in urban areas) and production of the city (the day-to-day making of the urban fabric and its functions/uses) are actually carried out in Brussels. In
<u>date</u>	concrete terms, this will lead to questions about the diversity of urban productive activities, their organisation and spatialisation, the jobs they generate and their integration into the urban economy

	 For a valid application, the candidate must: be, either already holder of a Master degree, or currently enrolled in a Master program / a PhD program
	 have a fluent English level and good knowledge of French assure his/her continuous presence during the two weeks of the MasterClass.
